This describes the effects of religious on our sample. For the purposes of the above information, we have INCLUDED religious salaries
- We used 2% as our cost of living increase, but you can use a different number - see the instructions for how to do this
- Actual average salaries are calculated on information provided by schools to the OCE for 11/12 and reflect consolidations, closures etc.
- This data sample contains only information provided to the Office of Catholic Education. Some schools choose not to provide salary data
- Three of the 13 districts are reporting a decrease in salaries, it is assumed that this is due primarily with dissimilar data from year to year
- Previous year amounts do not include adjustments for personnel changes within districts
- Consolidation and merger activities allow for reductions in average salary from year to year.
