Three years ago the school successfully completed a \$13 million dollar capital campaign. Increased donations have provided for recent expansion and facilities upgrades, as well as a strengthening of the endowment fund.

The school is a co-educational Catholic secondary school educating students in grades nine through twelve. Fully accredited by the North Central Accrediting Association and with the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association, Cleveland Central Catholic serves a diverse student population of 536 students.
